## Wilson Health Earns ACHC Accreditation in 2025

Following an on-site survey in July 2025, Wilson Health achieved a three-year re-accreditation from the Accreditation Commission for Health Care (ACHC). ACHC is an organization certified by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to ensure hospitals caring for Medicare patients meet patient safety and quality requirements. Accreditation by ACHC is a process through which health care organizations demonstrate compliance with national standards. It reflects Wilson Health's dedication and commitment to meeting high standards that facilitate a higher level of performance and patient care.



## Wilson Health Earns Awards for Excellence in Stroke Care

Wilson Health received the American Heart Association's Get With The Guidelines® - Stroke Silver Plus and the Rural Stroke Bronze quality achievement awards for its commitment to ensuring stroke patients receive the most appropriate treatment according to nationally recognized, research-based guidelines, ultimately leading to more lives saved and reduced disability.

Wilson Health is certified through the ACHC as a Stroke-Ready Hospital able to meet the initial needs of stroke patients that present at the hospital.



## Bringing 3D Mammography Screening Directly to Patients

Our mobile mammography coach debuted in late 2025 making it easy and convenient to get your annual screening mammogram—an essential step for early detection of breast cancer. The coach travels to businesses and community locations throughout the region.

Inside, you'll find the same state-of-the-art Genius™ 3-D Mammography™ technology used at Wilson Health's Francis Women's Center. All screenings are reviewed by experienced radiologists, and your results are sent directly to you and your physician.

Enjoy a welcoming atmosphere with a reception area, private dressing rooms, a restroom, and a comfortable mammography suite.

Women age 40 and older can schedule a screening mammogram on the coach without a physician's order; appointments are required.

## Eligibility for Mobile Mammography

Mobile mammography is available for women who:

- Are 40 or older (no physician's order needed)
- Are under 40 with a physician's order
- Haven't had a mammogram in the last 12 months
- Don't have symptoms such as a lump or nipple discharge
- Can walk and safely use the coach's stairs

If you've had mammograms at another hospital or health system, just let us know when you schedule—we'll handle transferring your records.

# Family Birth Center

## Caring for Families from the Very Beginning

Wilson Health's Family Birth Center supports parents every step of the way. From the first prenatal visit to those first days at home with a newborn, Wilson Health's Family Birth Center is built around one goal: making sure families feel supported, informed, and cared for at every stage of their journey.

In 2025, the Family Birth Center delivered 700 newborns. With 11 physicians, advanced practice providers, and midwives, Wilson Health employs the largest OB/GYN group in the upper Miami Valley and is the only birthing center located in Shelby and Miami counties.

"At Wilson Health, we focus on the full continuum of care so families feel supported prior to pregnancy through delivery and life at home afterward," said Jenny Dietz, Director of Women's Services at Wilson Health. "Our goal is to make sure parents never feel like they're navigating this journey alone."

That approach includes close collaboration among OB-GYNs, certified nurse midwives, primary care providers, pediatric teams, and lactation specialists. By working together before, during, and after birth, the team helps ensure care feels coordinated and personalized for each family.



Another important piece is Wilson Health's partnership with Dayton Children's Hospital. Neonatal providers from Dayton Children's are on staff and available to support all babies born at Wilson Health, bringing specialized newborn care directly to the community.

"Having newborn expertise available locally is incredibly important for families," Dietz said. "It gives parents added peace of mind knowing their baby has access to specialized care right here at Wilson Health."

# Donor Spotlight



For nearly five decades, JoAnn Koenig has been a familiar name in both the business and nonprofit communities of Shelby County. After a 47-year career as an accountant at Koenig Equipment, she continues to give her time, talents, and heart to causes that matter most to her.

Born and raised in Botkins in a large, close-knit family with ten siblings, JoAnn learned the importance of community service from her parents, who showed that giving doesn't always mean giving money, but giving of yourself. "My parents made the time to give of their time, talents, and resources to organizations they supported," JoAnn shared. "I feel very blessed and fortunate that I am able to follow in their footsteps and 'pay it forward' to organizations I feel passionate about."

Today, JoAnn carries that legacy through many community roles. She has served as a Wilson Health Auxiliary volunteer since 2023 and is a steadfast supporter of Wilson Health Foundation's Annual Golf Outing and Casino Night. She also supports the Botkins Education Foundation, where she has been a trustee and treasurer since 2018, and the Community Foundation of Shelby County, where she participates in the Legacy Society and supports both a Donor Advised Fund and a Scholarship Fund.

Her commitment to service runs deep. She volunteered more than 20 years as an EMT and paramedic with the Anna Rescue Squad, taught CPR and first aid through the American Red Cross, and mentored youth through Big Brothers Big Sisters of Shelby and Darke County, where she also served as trustee and board president. "I've met some very special people in my involvement with the Wilson Health Auxiliary, hospital staff, and foundation employees," she says. # Angel Fund

The Angel Fund program is designed to help Wilson Health Hospice patients financially during challenging times. Last year, the Angel Fund paid out over \$23,153 to assist patients in need. Hospice patients' caregiving needs and costs often increase and they must rely on family and friends to help. When this occurs, caregivers may have to leave employment or cut hours to meet their caregiving needs. The Angel Fund helps alleviate added financial burdens and can help pay for things like rent, utilities, groceries, etc. This program is a blessing to many in our community.


These numbers represent far more than time spent—they reflect comforting conversations, helping hands, and meaningful moments of kindness throughout our hospital and community.
